

Smiles for Charity



The annual **Smiles for Charity Drive** sponsored by Braydich Dental has raised over \$12,000.00 to benefit the Hubbard Public Library since March of this year.

"The drive has helped many local and national organizations over the past nine years," Dr. Braydich stated. The goal this year was to raise \$10,000.00 for the Hubbard Library. According to Library Director, Sherry Ault, "These dollars will make a huge difference at the Library which has been hit by significant budget cutbacks in recent years due to reduced state tax revenue."

"The generous donation from Braydich Dental is a tremendous benefit to the community. We were recently advised by the Department of Taxation that the Library will receive at least \$10,500 fewer dollars than estimated for this year, so the **Smiles for Charity** gift is much appreciated," says Ault.

This gift will directly benefit the community as the Library plans to purchase a disc repair system to keep the Library's compact discs and DVDs in good condition. **Smiles for Charity** dollars will also be used to provide free digital music downloads for Library patrons and Ault is exploring the possibility of purchasing e-books and e-audiobooks with this gift.

Braydich Dental donated all the time and materials needed to create custom fitted whitening trays for clients. The fee of \$100 was collected and the entire amount is being donated to the Library.
